**Note:** Set times and amounts to what you desire.

**1. Edit an existing Priority Parsing file.**

- 1a. To edit an existing file, select '**Configuration**' from the Operator Console Main Menu.
- 1b. Choose item 5, '**Priority Parsing**'.
- 1c. Highlight the Priority Parsing File you will be editing.
- 1d. Click on, '**Edit**'.
- 1e. Once inside the file, you will use blank dial patterns to add any or all of the new entries listed below.
- 1f. **NOTE: ONLY FOR PNM Plus version 2.2.0 and higher**, type the pattern ending with **+**. For all versions **2.1.0 and under**, use the **\*** to end the dial pattern. Our examples will use the dial patterns for version 2.1.0 and under.

For Dominican Republic: (area codes 809 & 829)

- 1g1. For the first 'Dial Pattern', type: **1809\***.
- 1g2. Under '**Macro Number**', type **50**. (This refers to the macro you made from page 1)
- 1g3. '**Completion Timer**' can remain a **!**.
- 1g4. For '**Initial Rate**', type: **1.00** and for '**Initial Time**', type: **4**
- 1g5. For '**Additional Rate**', type: **1.00** and for '**Additional Time**', type: **4**
- 1g6. '**Call Type**' can remain a **!**.
  
- 1h1. For the next 'Dial Pattern', type: **1829\***.
- 1h2. Repeat steps 1g2 to 1g6.

For Puerto Rico: (area codes 787 & 939)

- 1i1. For the next 'Dial Pattern', type: **1787\***.
- 1i2. Repeat steps 1g2 to 1g6.
  
- 1j1. For the next 'Dial Pattern', type: **1939\***.
- 1j2. Repeat steps 1g2 to 1g6.

For Jamaica: (area code 876)

- 1k1. For the next 'Dial Pattern', type: **1876\***.
- 1k2. Repeat steps 1g2 to 1g6.

**(NOTE: Optional programming for Canada)**

For Canada: (area codes: 204, 250, 306, 403, 416, 418, 450, 506, 514, 519, 604, 613, 705, 709, 807, 819, 867, 902, 905)

- 1l1. For the next 'Dial Pattern', type: **1204\***.
- 1l2. Repeat steps 1g2 to 1g6.
- 1l3. Repeat steps 1l1 and 1l2 for all other Canadian area codes you wish to include.
  
- 1m. There are other NADP countries that can be included should you want to add more. Please contact our office to obtain a list.
- 1n. Click '**OK**' and when finished editing all other priority parsing files, click '**Close**'.

**2. Download and test.**

- 2a. Download to one phone and make test calls.
- 2b. if satisfied with testing, repeat all steps and download all other phones.
